In 1998, Dr. LaKeacha Jett began her teaching career in Baltimore City Public Schools. She has taught 2nd-5th grades, while hosting clubs, being a Technology Liaison and serving as the School-wide Enrichment Manager. In 2003, she was named Teacher of the Year for Arlington Elementary School. In 2005, Dr. Jett began working in Clayton County Public Schools where she has served at several schools in various roles, supporting students from Kindergarten through 8th grades. In 2007, she founded a non-profit organization for girls, Social Butterflies, Inc. and published the Free to Be Me Curriculum, that has operated in multiple schools in CCPS. In 2012, she earned a Doctorate Degree in Curriculum & Instruction and also published a novel, Egregious Acts.

As an Instructional Support Teacher at Huie Elementary School, Dr. Jett has an uncanny ability to establish trust and work well with teachers through mentoring, coaching and leading professional learning experiences. Dr. Jett builds the climate and culture of schools by initiating positive programs for teachers and designing beautiful staff events.
